

In its ongoing effort to control the spread of the virus into and within the borders of Antigua and Barbuda, the Government has taken the decision to continue the currently imposed restriction on **ALL inbound commercial traffic until 14<sup>th</sup> May 2020 in the first instance.**

**However, until otherwise stipulated, regional inbound and outbound passenger and cargo flights by LIAT, other cargo flight operators, private jets, small private aircraft, military flights and customary small carriers will be permitted to land subject to special approval.**

Any airline wishing to fly an empty aircraft in order to collect citizens of their countries for return to their originating cities will only be allowed to do so with proper advance notification and authorization.

All previously imposed strictures governing inbound commercial travel remain in place for the above-stated period. In the interim, citizens of Antigua and Barbuda as well as resident diplomats will be allowed entry. **All** citizens arriving on LIAT/private flights will be quarantined. **Citizens returning from the Dominican Republic will be required to undergo two (2) weeks quarantine prior to return AND two (2) weeks upon return to Antigua and Barbuda.** Flight organizers are kindly asked to provide advance passenger information of the scheduled arrival of citizens in order to facilitate the necessary quarantine. **ENDS**
